| 5. | Quilts will not be judged. The winners of each category will be Viewer's Choice. |
| 6. | Voting will be completed by Saturday at $5: 00 \mathrm{pm}$. Ribbons will be displayed on the winning quilts on Sunday. |

|  | Quilts are to be picked up between 5:00 pm and 5:30 pm on Sunday at Dawes County Fairgrounds. |

Small Art Quilt or Wall Hanging: Designed to hang on a wall. Any quilting technique. Total outside dimension $<150$ " $P$.
Miniature: Total outside dimension of 120 " or less. All components are miniature in scale. Individual blocks 4.5 " or less J.

Miscellaneous: Vest, jacket, dress, apron, purse or bag, table runner, placemat, pillow, etc.

Youth: Any item or technique. Construction completed by youth<19 years old. May be quilted by someone else. L.

Challenge Quilt: Must meet requirements of the Challenge Quilt rules (refer to www.chadronfestivalofquilts.com) M.

Heirloom Quilts: Vintage or Antique quilts greater than 50 years old. Any size or technique.

Machine Embroidered Quilts: 50\% or more machine embroidery with any quilting technique. Dimension $>200$ inches. 0.
